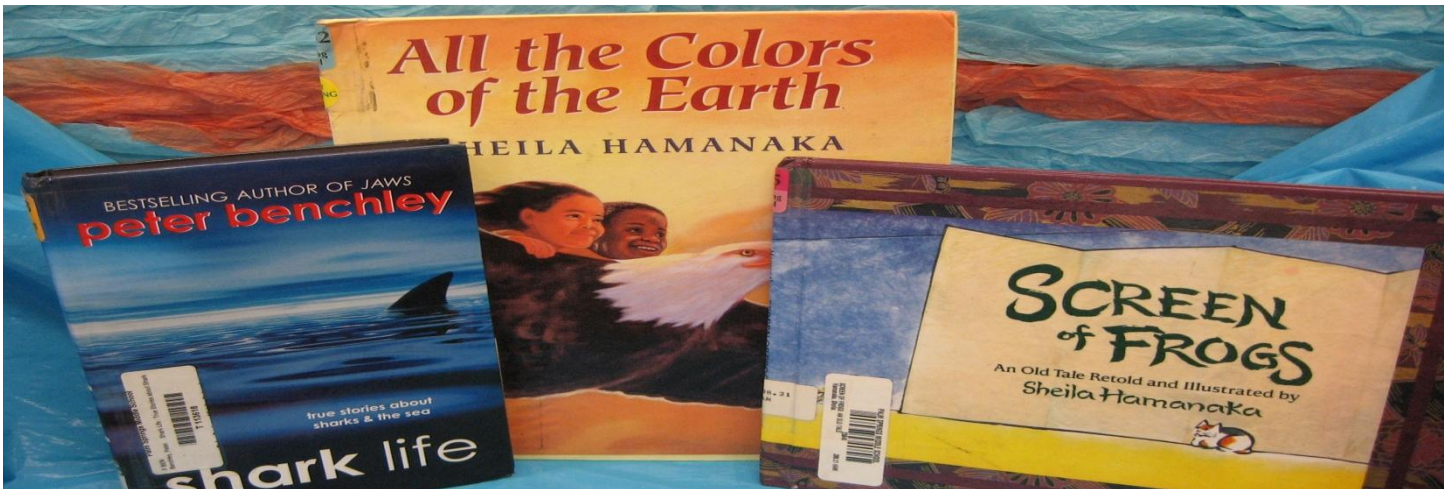


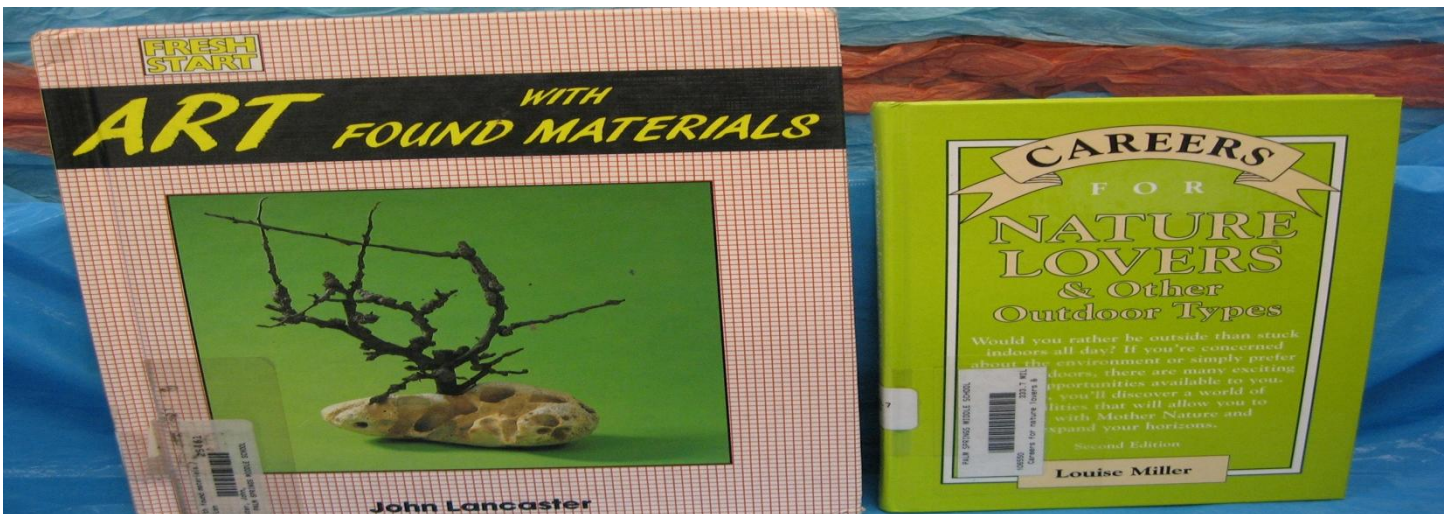
# Celebrate Earth Day!
