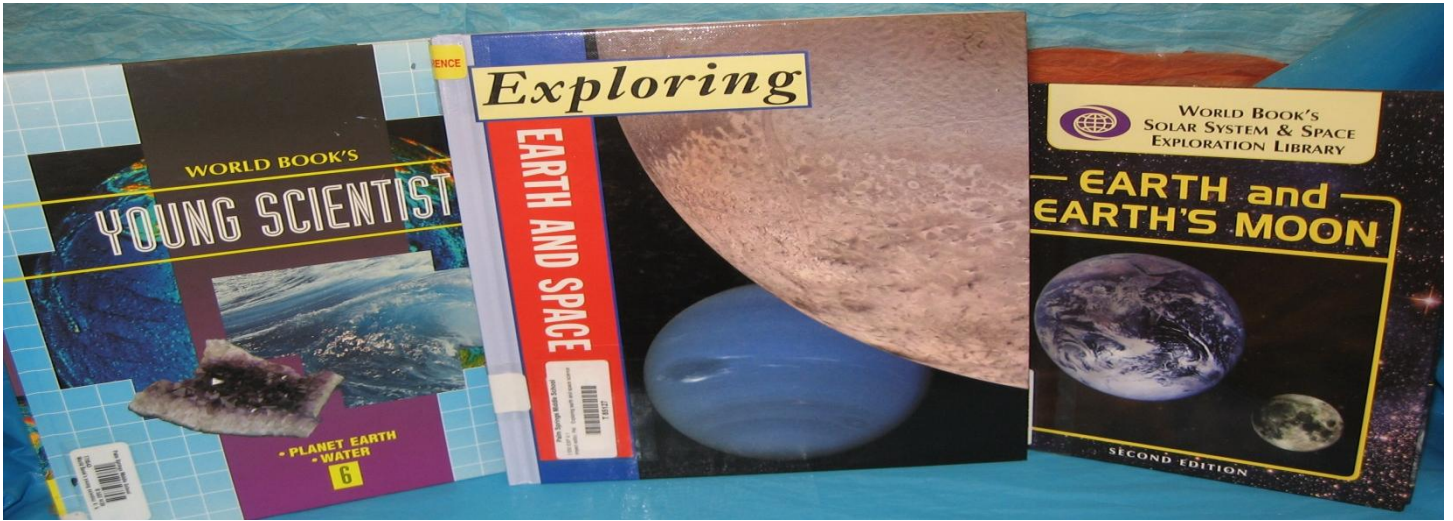

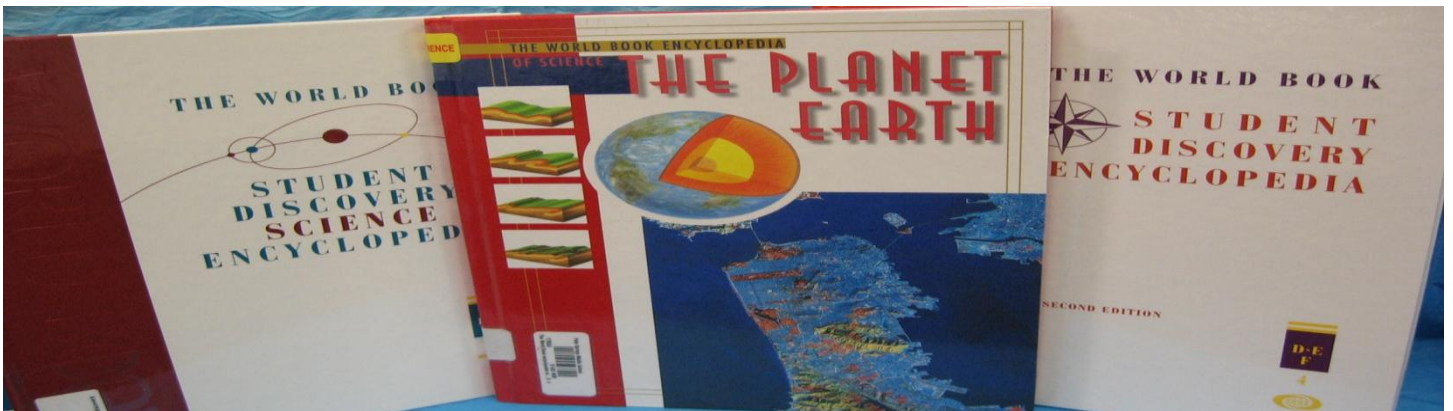
## REFERENCE BOOKS
