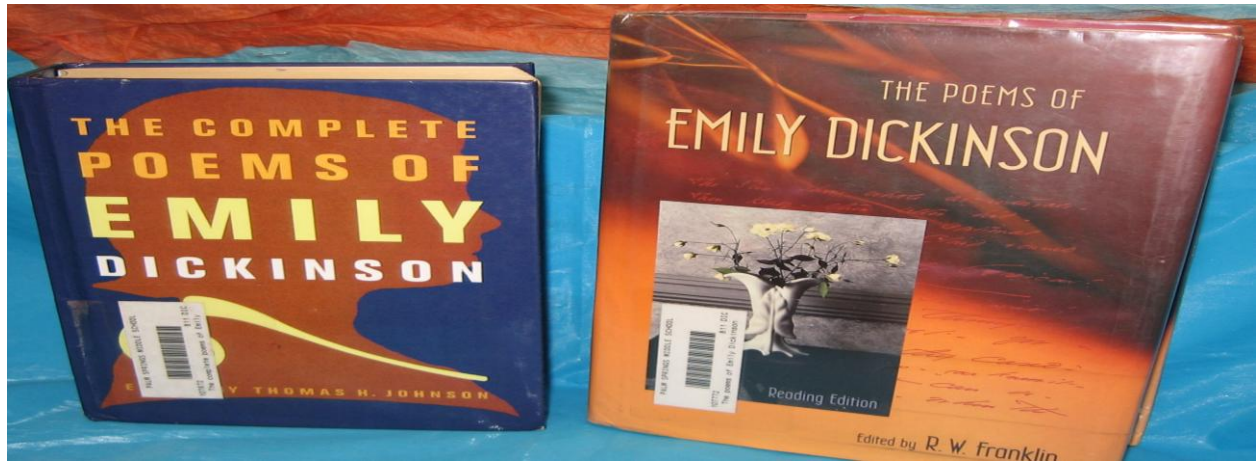


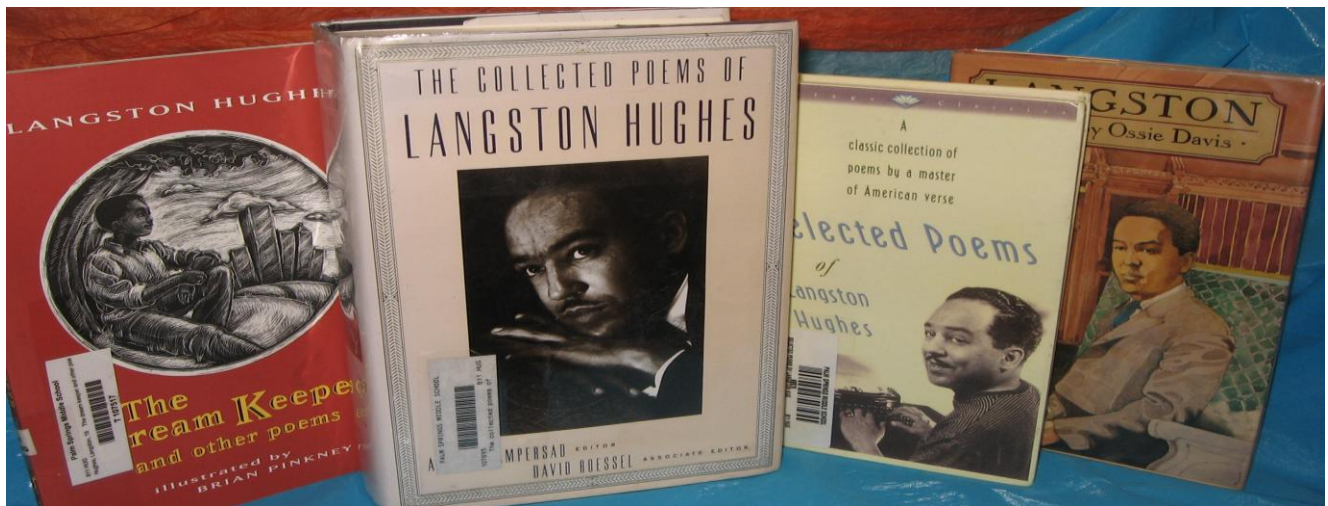

Emily Dickinson/Langston Hughes



The Complete POEMS Of Emily Dickinson- Presents the original texts of all 1,775 poems written by nineteenth-century poet Emily Dickinson, arranged chronologically by date of composition.

The Poems of Emily Dickinson- A collection of 1,789 poems of American poet Emily Dickinson with an interpretive introduction.



Langston Hughes (The Dream Keeper) a collection of sixty-six poems, selected by the author for young readers, including lyrical poems, songs, and blues, many exploring the black experience.

The Collected Poems of Langston Hughes-a complete collection of Hughes's poetry spanning five decades, from the 1920s through the 1960s.

Selected Poems of Langston Hughes- A collection of poems reflecting the experiences of African-Americans, chosen by the author from works he created at all stages of his career.

Langston –A Play by Ossie Davis- Poet Langston Hughes visits a church basement where a drama group is rehearsing one of his plays, and uses the actors to recreate scenes from his early life.
