Edgar Allan Poe shaped the development of both the detective story and the science-fiction story. Some of his poems "The Raven," "The Bells," "Annabel Lee"—remain among the most popular in American Literature.

***Tales of Edgar Allan Poe-*** A collection of adaptations of works by Edgar Allan Poe. Take a look at some strange tales. Poe said his tales are stories about morals. But they are filled with bizarre happenings and terror. Take a peek at a scene from "The Cask of Amontillado" if you dare!

***Edgar Allan Poe (Poetry, Tales, and Selected Essays)*** A comprehensive collection of nineteenth-century American author Edgar Allan Poe's works, including well-known and early poems and stories, essays on poetry and criticism, humorous sketches, the verse drama "Politian," and his last major piece, the prose poem "Eureka."

***Edgar Allan Poe (Complete Poems)*** Poe's poetry, which is collected in this volume, is more personal than his prose. The themes of love, death, and despair which recur throughout reflect the anguish he suffered in his own troubled life. Poe's best poems remain some of the most popular and technically accomplished in the English Language.
