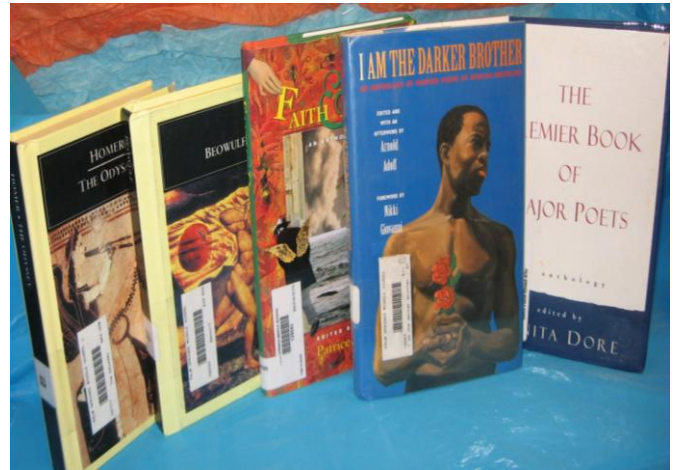
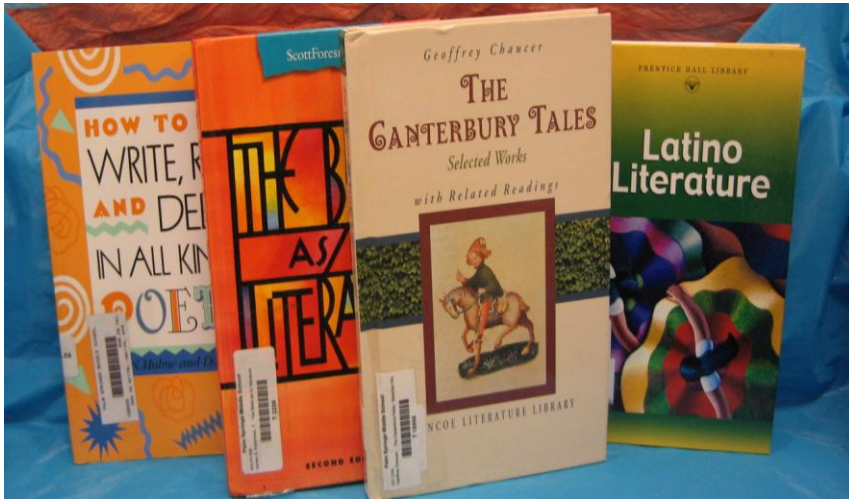


## Literature Books & Anthologies



***How to Write, Recite, Delight in all kinds of POETRY-*** Young people are encouraged to experiment with a variety of poetic forms and to recite and preserve their creations.

***The Bible as in Literature-*** presents key biblical selections with literature that relates to them. It helps readers recognize biblical allusions, symbols, and themes in literature and the other humanities, including the visual arts.

***The Canterbury Tales Selected Works with Related Readings-***This volume includes verse translations by two major Chaucer scholars: Nevill Coghill and David Wright.

***Latino Literature-*** Includes a collection of classic works by current Latino writers such as Sandra Cisneros, William Carlos Williams, and Judith Ortiz Cofer.

***The Odyssey-*** The epic poem recounting the experiences of Odysseus during his return from the Trojan War.

***Beowulf-*** Tells the story of the hero Beowulf, the Anglo-Saxon poem Beowulf marks the beginning of English Literature.

***Faith & Doubt (An anthology of poems)-*** A collection of poems that explore the many facets of human faith and doubt.

***I am the Darker Brother: An Anthology of modern poems by African Americans-*** Poems on aspects of race or racial problems by well-known African-American poets, including Countee Cullen, Richard Wright, and Maya Angelou.

***The Premier Book of Major Poets (An Anthology)-*** An anthology of poems arranged around major themes such as love, war, liberty, peace, alienation, urban life, and the generation gap.
