
Literature Books & Anthologies



How to Write, Recite, Delight in all kinds of POETRY- Young people are encouraged to experiment with a variety of poetic forms and to recite and preserve their creations.

The Bible as in Literature – presents key biblical selections with literature that relates to them. It helps readers recognize biblical allusions, symbols, and themes in literature and the other humanities, including the visual arts.

The Canterbury Tales Selected Works with Related Readings-This volume includes verse translations by two major Chaucer scholars: Nevill Coghill and David Wright.

Latino Literature- Includes a collection of classic works by current Latino writers such as Sandra Cisneros, William Carlos Williamsm, and Judith Ortiz Cofer.

The Odyssey- The epic poem recounting the experiences of Odysseus during his return from the Trojan War.

Beowulf- Tells the story of the hero Beowulf, the Anglo-Saxon poem Beowulf marks the beginning of English Literature.

Faith & Doubt (An anthology of poems)- A collection of poems that explore the many facets of human faith and doubt.

I am the Darker Brother: An Anthology of modern poems by African Americans-Poems on aspects of race or racial problems by well-known African-American poets, including Countee Cullen, Richard Wright, and Maya Angelou.

The Premier Book of Major Poets (An Anthology)- An anthology of poems arranged around major themes such as love, war, liberty, peace, alienation, urban life, and the generation gap.
