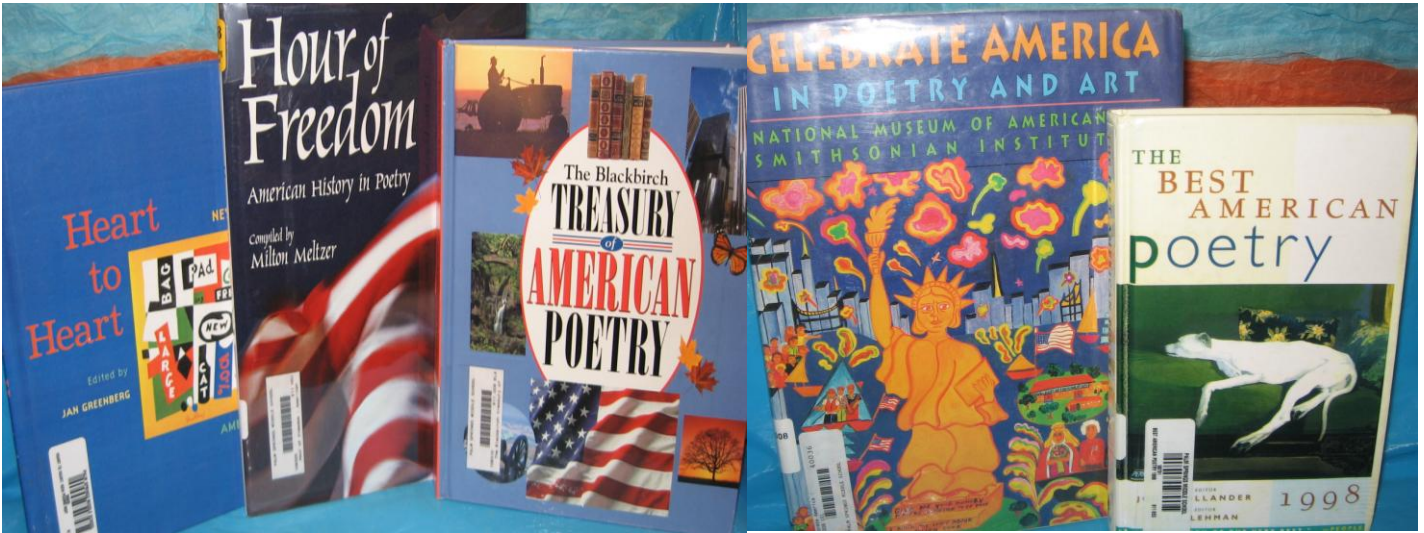


NATIONAL POETRY MONTH

Heart to Heart A compilation of poems by Americans writing about American art in the twentieth century, including such writers as Nancy Willard, Jane Yolen, and X. J. Kennedy.

Hour of Freedom- A selection of over fifty-nine poems about America. This rich important collection features brief notations that precede each poem, placing each work in the context of the period. Biographies of each poet illuminate each life. Here is a major poetry anthology that gives young readers "the poets" sense of the past, as well as of the life around them...to extend and deepen the range of our own experience."

The Blackbirch Treasury of American Poetry- A collection of poems by such major American poets as Sandburg, Frost, Whitman, and Longfellow. Special features include a biography of each poet; definitions of the harder vocabulary and a commentary to help readers better appreciate the sound and rhythm of the verses and better understand the deeper meanings of each selection.

Celebrate America in Poetry and Art- Text and accompanying photographs present a collection of American poetry that celebrates over 200 years of American life and history as illustrated by fine art from the collection of the National Museum of American Art.

The Best American Poetry- An annual collection of seventy-five poems, selected as the best America has to offer. This book is a work of fiction. Names, characters, places, and incidents either are products of the author's imagination or are used fictitiously. Any resemblance to actual events or locales or persons, living or dead, is entirely coincidental.
