

NATIONAL POETRY MONTH



Classic Poetry: an illustrated Collection- A collection of favorite poems by such writers as William Shakespeare, Emily Dickinson, Edward Lear, Walt Whitman, and Langston Hughes, with portraits of the poets, brief biographical background, and illustrations.

The Roald Dahl Treasury- Presents selections from the writings of English author Roald Dahl, with over fifty stories, rhymes, memoirs, letters, and poems arranged by theme.

100 Great Poems of the Twentieth Century- Presents a collection of one hundred poems of the twentieth century by such noted authors as T.S. Eliot, Robert Frost, Ezra Pound, Ogden Nash, Edna St. Vincent Millay, and others.



Christmas in the Big House, Christmas in the Quarters- Describes the customs, recipes, poems, and songs used to celebrate Christmas in the big plantation houses and in the slave quarters just before the Civil War.

Something Permanent-Photographs and poems tell the story of ordinary people living in America during the Great Depression.

Benn to yesterdays (**Poems of a Life**)- Autobiographical poems capture a thirteen-year-old boy's feelings, experiences, and aspirations in one tumultuous year of his life.

Poems and Letters-A selection of poems and letters by English poets Robert and Elizabeth Barrett Browning, focusing on works that reflect their relationship with each other.
