

*Fearless Fernie: Hanging out with Fernie and Me-* An illustrated collection of poems about two best friends and the trials of the middle school years.

*Walking on the Boundaries of Changes: Poems Of Transition-* A collection of poems about issues facing young adults, from new experiences to making choices.

*Swimming Upstream: Middle School Poems-* A collection of poems capture the feelings and experiences of a girl in middle school.

*Everywhere FACES Everywhere-*A collection of poems exploring the diversity found in a childhood in Jamaica and later observations of young people in England.

*Laughs-* A collection of twenty-four stories and poems designed to make you laugh.



*Good Luck Gold and Other Poems-* A collection of poems reflecting the poet's experiences growing up as a multicultural Asian-American child in Los Angeles

*The firefly Letters-* Collects poems from Cuban-American poet Margarita Engle in which she explores women rights with various historical viewpoints.

*The Surrender Tree: Poems of Cuba's Struggle for Freedom-* A collection of poems in which Rosa, a healer, describes her experiences trying to help Cuban peasants who have been forced to leave their farms and villages in 1896 and given eight days to find their way to "reconcentration camps" or be killed.

*The Prophet-* A classic, published in 1923, containing 28 prose poems. This edition features twelve full-page mystical drawings by the famous Lebanese poet, philosopher and artist.
