Water—about 70 percent of the earth’s surface and 50 to 65 percent of every human body—is the inspiration for *River of Words*, a heartening collection of art and poetry created by children under the auspices of the organization by the same name.

Winter Poems- A collection of winter poems ranging from late fall to early spring, by such authors as Shakespeare, Edgar Allan Poe, and Wallace Stevens.

Footprints on the Roof: poem about the earth- Presents nineteen poems about Earth, including its weather, seasons, landforms, and animals, by American writer Marilyn Singer.

When a City Leans Against the Sky- A collection of poems that celebrates the many "lives" of a city.
