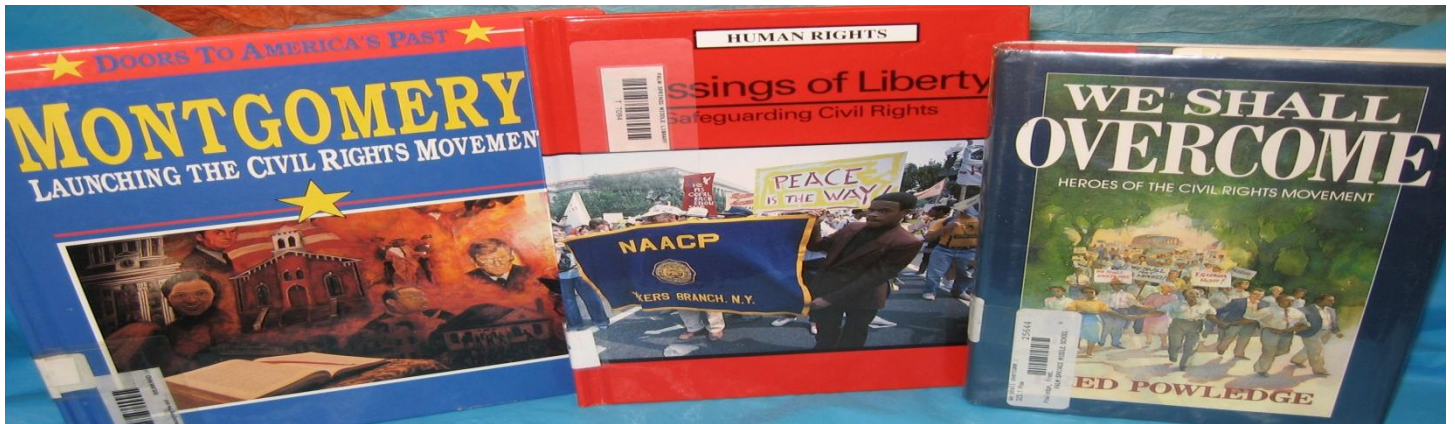


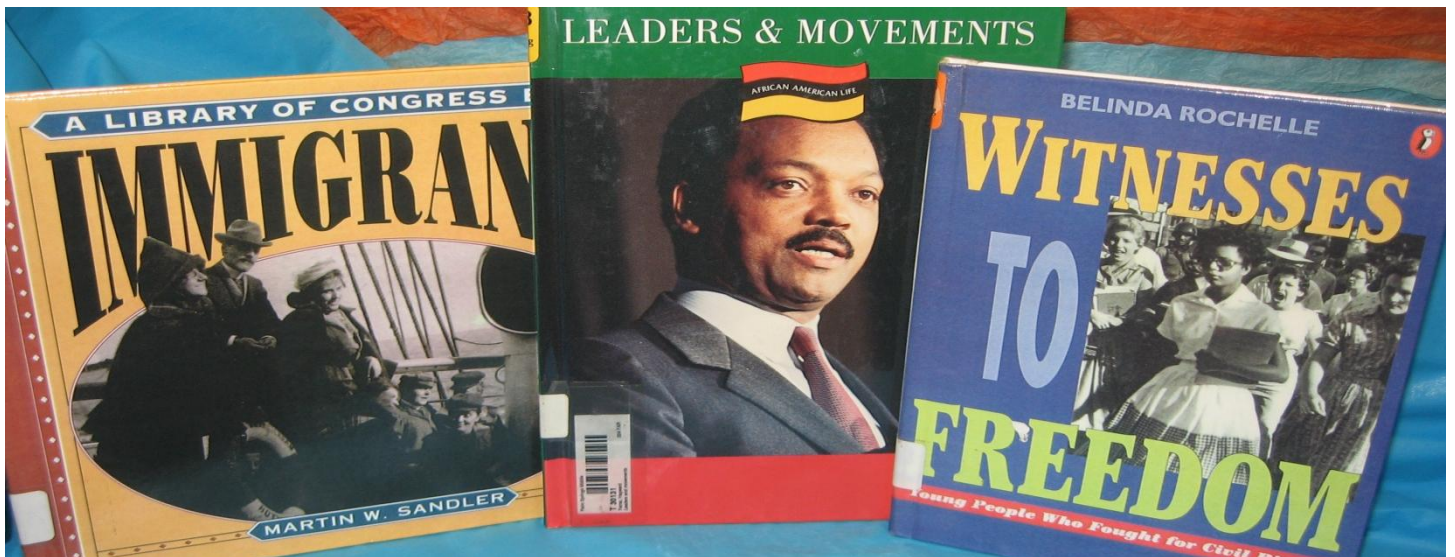
# CIVICS RESOURCES



**Montgomery launching the civil rights movement**-Describes the history of Montgomery, Alabama, and the events which roused public opinion throughout the country in support of the civil rights movement.

**Blessings of Liberty**-Text and photographs discuss various civil rights enjoyed by American citizens and insured by the Constitution, Bill of Rights, and state constitutions.

**We Shall Overcome**-Examines the system of segregation that existed in the United States until the mid-twentieth century and discusses the civil rights movement that changed this system.



**Immigrants**-Photographs, illustrations, and text show what it was like for people to leave their homes and immigrate to the United States.

**Leaders & Movements**-African American have struggled for social, economic, and political equality in the United States.

**Witnesses to Freedom**- Photographs and text describe the experiences of young African-Americans who were involved in significant events in the civil rights movement, including Brown vs. Board of Education, the Montgomery bus boycott, and the sit-in movement.
