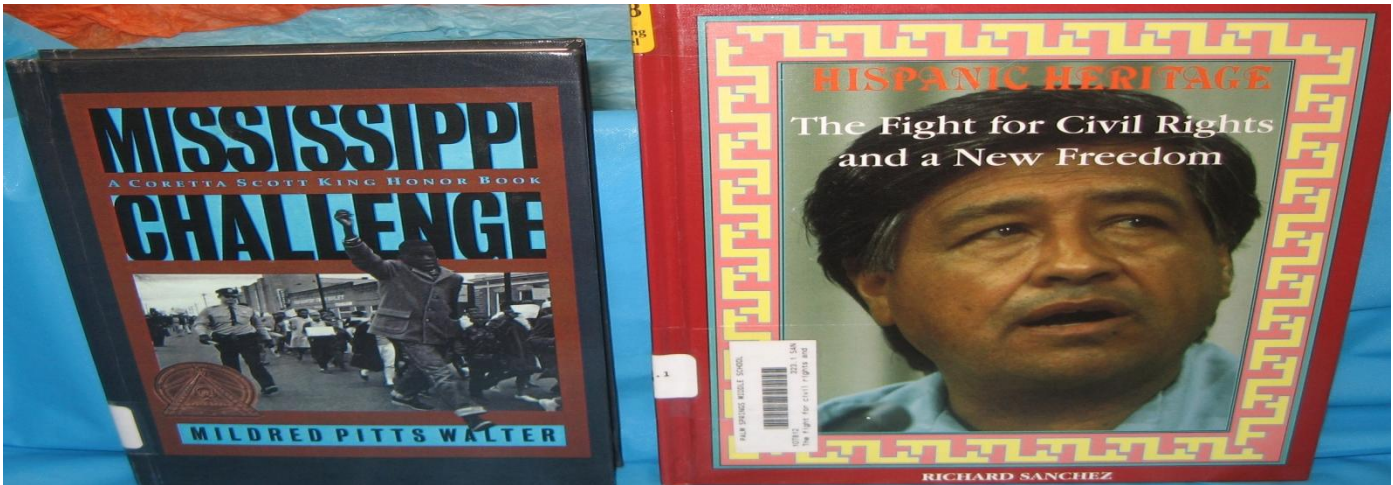
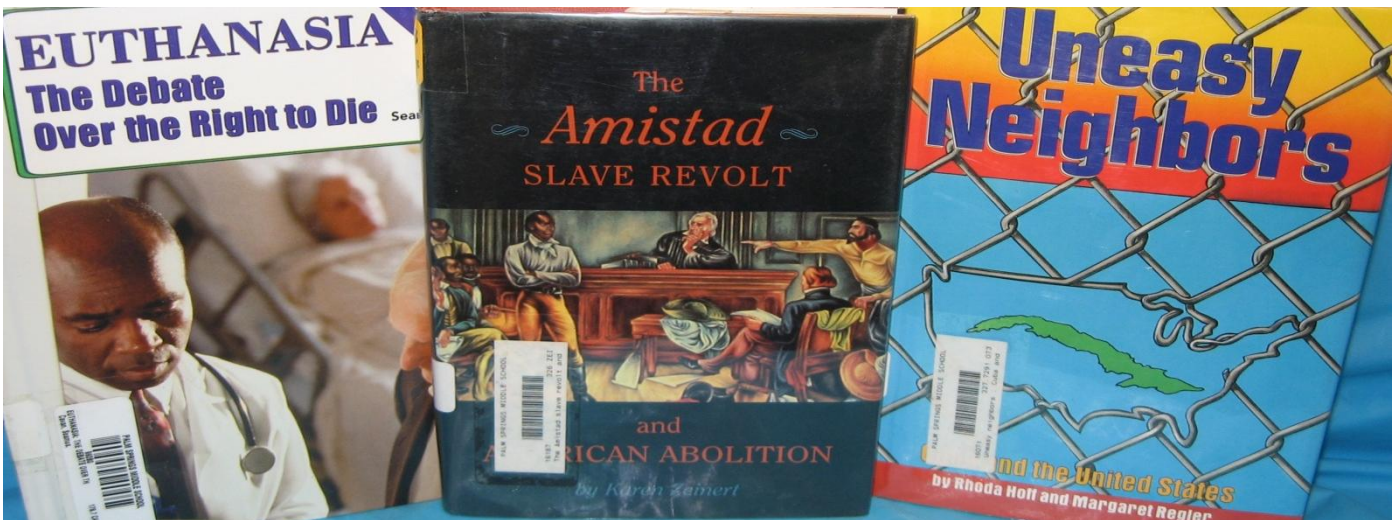


CIVICS RESOURCES



Mississippi Challenge- Describes the struggle for civil rights for African-Americans in Mississippi, from the time of slavery to the signing of the Voting Rights Act in 1965.

The fight for Civil Rights and New Freedom- Discusses the efforts of Hispanic Americans to secure civil rights and equal treatment under the law.



Euthanasia: The Debate Over the Right to Die- Addresses the ethical, moral, and legal issues raised by the subject of euthanasia.

The Amistad Slave Revolt- Traces the 1839 revolt of Africans aboard the slave ship Amistad, their apprehension, and long trial which ended in their acquittal by the Supreme Court.

Uneasy Neighbors: Cuban and the United States- A collection of letters, speeches, journal entries, and other source material provides an overview of Cuban history and a survey of the relations between the United States and Cuba since the end of World War II.
