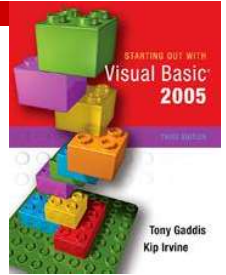
The Object Browser

The Object Browser Is a Dialog Box That Allows You to Browse All Classes and Components That Are Available to Your Project



Working with Collections

- Allows you to examine
 - Information about forms in your project
 - Classes you've created
 - Other components used by VB in your project
