- Spiral notebooks (3 to begin) & loose paper
- Small personal pencil sharpener
- 3 dividers
- Highlighters/color pencils
- Ruler & Protractor

Assignments:

- <u>All assignments/notes must be labeled with:</u>

- Students not having the assignment when collection begins will submit a sheet of paper with the heading as described above.

Class work and Homework:

- HW is assigned about twice per week
- Collected, graded & reviewed randomly.
- CW is given on a daily basis.

Notebook:

- 3 ring binder
- Randomly collected & graded
- 3 dividers (spiral notebook in each)
- 1) Notes & CW, 2) HW, 3) Alternative

Academics:

- DSR a <u>15 minute</u> FCAT type review exercise will be on the board for you to begin <u>immediately</u> when you walk in.
- DSR's cannot be made up. It is the student's responsibility to get the missed DSR from a fellow classmate for the purpose of having it to study. (DSR's will be included in guizzes & tests.)
- In addition to HW, CW & Journal, Active <u>participation</u> is <u>required</u>. Record-keeping of such will be made.

Attendance:

Student is responsible to ask for make up notes, CW, HW, etc.

(A clipboard will be available for students to check for work missed while absent. Additionally, my website will soon be available for this purpose.)

- Excused absences students are allowed make up of any assignments missed and turned in by the next 2 class sessions.
- Unexcused absences will receive a zero (0) and no makeup are allowed for any assignments
