Intensive Math Cognitive Tutor Syllabus

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Assignments:

- 1. <u>Class notes:</u> Students are required to take class notes. All notes must be labeled with the student's Name, Date, and Period. There are no excuses for not taking class notes.
- 2. <u>Home-learning:</u> Students will have HW assignments on an average of twice per week. HW will be collected, graded, and reviewed randomly. If student is absent on the due date, HW must be brought to class the first day the student returns. If HW is not turned in on that very day then it = Z. Furthermore, HW must be **done** in **pencil**. Students are expected to ask and answer questions about the HW. To receive credit, all work must be shown; **answers only = Z.** It is very important that you do your HW every time it is assigned, not only does it count as part of your final grad, but also **more importantly,** it will prepare you for the quizzes and tests.
- 3. <u>Notebook:</u> Students are required to have a notebook (**3-ring binder**.) The notebook may be collected at least once (randomly at any time) during each nine-week grading period and will **count as a quiz grade**. The notebook will be made up of four (4) sections: NOTES and algebra ASSIGNMENTS, geometry assignment, probability assignments.

ATTENDANCE:

- 1. Attendance: Attendance is of utmost importance because you will be missing out on the classroom explanation or group activities. When you are absent it is **your responsibility to ask for any makeup notes, etc.** Students with excused absences only will be allowed to replace the missed quiz by the test exam. However, any student who has an unexcused absence will receive a zero (0) for each test or quiz. If you miss a test, you will have two (2) days to make up with an excused absence only. Once again, if student is absent, HW must be turned in on the very day student returns. If absent student, does not turn in HW, he/she receives a Z for that HW.
- 2. <u>Tardies:</u> The school wide tardy policy will be enforced. **DO NOT get caught in HALL SWEEPS** (unexcused absence) as this will automatically give you a "Z" for the day whether it's a CW assignment or a test.

1. <u>Grade:</u> Grades are based on Class work, Home Learning, Quizzes, Tests, Presentations, and Journals.
