#### **Vision Statement:**

#### **Mission Statement:**

Students currently enrolled in Economics with Financial Literacy/U.S. Government through FLVS must adhere to policies set forth by FLVS. All students in violation of these policies will be subject to the consequences delineated in the American Senior High School Florida Virtual School Contract.

## **Examples of Academic Integrity Violations:**

- 1. Submitting all or a portion of another student's work as your own
- 2. Knowingly sharing your work with another student
- 3. Copying/pasting information from unapproved sources
- 4. Failure to properly cite information from outside sources
- 5. Failing to safeguard your own work
  - a. Failure to log off your FLVS account anytime you are not at your computer
  - b. Sharing your username and password
  - c. Saving your work on an unsecured shared computer

### **Consequences:**

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Administrative phone call home. Additionally, student must serve a lunch or after school detention.

 $2^{nd}$  Offense: Administrative phone call home; this offense will be recorded in student's academic record via a referral. Student must also serve a Saturday detention at American Senior High from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. where the student will be required to hand write a 2 page-reflection paper on plagiarism.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense and beyond: Administrative phone call home; this offense will be recorded in student's academic record via a referral. Student will also begin to lose senior activity privileges. One activity will be lost for each academic integrity violation incurred. (*Parent: This may result in your child being unable to participate in such senior activities as Homecoming, Prom, and even Graduation.*)
