A

C

Program compiles; however, **is logically incorrect**; code may or may not be properly indented and/or documented; objects may or may not be properly named and their properties set up; may or may not have complete and appropriate internal documentation/comments.

D

Program does not compile; may or may not be logically correct; objects may or may not be properly named and their properties set up; code may or may not be properly indented and/or documented.

F

Program **is not complete** (50-99% built).

I

Program is not complete (**under 50% built**).

Z

Program file does not exist (**not collected**)
