- A The graphics and text used on the design project reflect an **exceptional degree of student creativity** in their creation and/or display. The design project is **exceptionally attractive** in terms of design, layout, neatness, size, etc. **All** graphics are **related to the topic** and **all** make it **easier to understand**.
- B The graphics and text used on the design project reflect **student creativity** in their creation and/or display. The design project is attractive in terms of design, layout and neatness and demonstrates an understanding of the use of design tools. **All** graphics are **related to the topic** and **most** make it **easier to understand**.
- C The graphics and text that were used by the student are **based on the designs or ideas of others and don't demonstrate original ideas**. The design project is **acceptably attractive** though it may be a **bit disorganized** and **does not demonstrate a clear understanding** of the use of **design tools**. All graphics relate to the topic and **some** make it **easier to understand**.
- D Graphics and text do not demonstrate any original thought or creativity. The design project is distractingly cluttered or devoid of necessary elements and very poorly designed. It is not attractive. Graphics do not relate to the topic.
- F Incomplete, but over 50% built.
- I Incomplete; less than 50% built.
