

Two-Point Scoring Rubric
For Short Response Questions

Two (2) points indicates that the student has a complete understanding of the reading concept embodied in the task. The student has provided a response that is accurate, complete, and fulfills all the requirements of the task. All necessary support and/or examples are included, and the information given is clearly text based.

One (1) point indicates that the student has a partial understanding of the reading concept embodied in the task. The student has provided a response that may include information that is essentially correct and text based, but the information is too general or too simplistic. Some of the support and/or examples may be incomplete or omitted.

Zero (0) points indicates the response is inaccurate, confused, and/or irrelevant, or the student failed to respond to the task.
